Onions and garlic

A component called thiosulphate, which can harm your pet's red blood cells and result in anemia, is present in onions and garlic and can be fatal.

Nuts

The cause of your dog's seizures, lethargy, vomiting, or loss of muscle control could be nut poisoning.

Raw eggs

Raw fish

Raw salmon may contain dangerous bacteria that can cause food poisoning in your pet, even though it is not naturally poisonous to dogs and cats.

Salt

Salt poisoning, which involves severe neurological symptoms like seizures and brain enlargement, can be brought on by consuming excessive amounts of salt.

Mushrooms

The wild variety usually causes more harm when compared to mushrooms from the grocery store. Even a few bites might cause seizures and vomiting.

Avocado

Huge avocado seeds have the potential to become lodged in the digestive tract, esophagus, or stomach of your pet.

Cherries

These fruits can cause dilated pupils, respiratory problems, shock, or even death in dogs and cats.

Fruit with pits

Avoid eating fruits with pits. They can suffocate your pet or block their intestines.

Grapes and raisins

Caffeine

The neurological system, heart, and other organs of your pet can be harmed by caffeine, a stimulant.

Alcohol

Oxalic acid, a substance found in rhubarb's leaves and stems, is poisonous.

Nutmeg

Myristicin, a toxin found in nutmeg, is poisonous to dogs.
