- 2. Autumn (September to early October): Autumn in Dal Lake has a unique charm with the onset of fall foliage. The weather remains pleasant, with temperatures ranging from 10 degrees to 25 degrees. The forest surroundings are adorned with hues of red and gold, creating a magical atmosphere.

How to Reach Dal Lake Mcleodganj

- Nearest airport: Gaggal airport is only 10 km from Dharamshala.
- The Nearest Railway station: Pathankot Cantt. (Chakki) (88 Km) is the nearest railway station. You can rent a car and experience lovely sightseeing on your way to the lake.
- Other transportation: Dal Lake is only 8 km from Dharamshala, you can rent a car or a bus to the spot or can travel straight from Delhi on an overnight Volvo bus direct to Dharamshala.

- It is recommended to carry warm clothes, woollen mufflers, and caps as it can get windy and cold.
- Wear proper footwear so that you can explore the area without hurting your feet.
- It is best to visit during the daytime to better enjoy the view.
